4.3. Syllabus

* Only those students who have previously communicated their participation in the same and those who have not passed one of the parts submitted to continuous evaluation or wish to upload the final grade, can be submitted to the single evaluation of week 15.

The relevant activities throughout the course are: - The dynamic activities, supervised work meetings and exposition, for which a date will be set throughout

the course, these activities are obligatory and will be announced in advance, and always before 15 days to the date of celebration.
