##### **4.1.Methodological overview**

The methodology followed in this course is oriented towards the achievement of the learning objectives. It favors the acquisition of CG 6,7,8 and 12; CT 4,6, 7 and 8; CE 9, 10, 12, 17 and 18. A wide range of teaching and learning tasks are implemented, such as lectures, practice sessions, autonomous work, tutorials, learning tasks and assessment tasks.

Students are expected to participate actively in the class throughout the semester.

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Classroom materials will be available via Moodle. These include a repository of the lecture notes used in class, the course syllabus, as well as other course-specific learning materials, including a discussion forum.

Further information regarding the course will be provided on the first day of class.

### 4.2.Learning tasks

This is a 6 ECTS course organized as follows:

- \* **Lectures** (20 hours). The teacher presents theoretical contents illustrated with relevant examples.
- \* **Practice sessions** (20 hours). They can include discussion and presentation of case studies, practical work outside the classroom (field work or visits), and seminars.
- \* **Autonomous work** (90 hours). Students do tasks such as study, readings, preparation of practice sessions and seminars, and summative assignments.
- \* **Tutorials** (2 hours). Office hours can be used to solved doubts and to follow-up the students' learning progress.
- \* **Assessment tasks** (2 hours). A final written examination.
