#### **4.1.Methodological overview**

The methodology followed in this course is oriented towards achievement of the learning objectives. A wide range of teaching and learning tasks are implemented, such as:

- Lectures. The teacher present and discuss in the classroom the theoretical and methodological aspects of the course contents. Student participation will be encouraged.
- Practice sessions, supervised by the teacher. Its aim is that students are able to take decisions that will allow them solving problems related to land use. Students familiarize with key information sources and the proper treatment of obtained information by applying the most common methods and techniques.
- Seminars. They promote, through discussion, reasoning skills and communication. The seminars will guide the exchange of ideas about issues that are included in the syllabus.

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- Field work. It will allow students to observe "in situ" some cases of territorial disorders and of ordered spaces. Fieldwork will help the student in the interpretation of the territory.
- Tutorials. They facilitate the monitoring process of the students' teaching-learning, practical assignments and seminar preparation.

### 4.2.Learning tasks

The course includes the following learning tasks:

- Lectures (20 hours).
- Practice sessions (15 hours). The methods and techniques commonly used in regional planning will be developed.
- Seminars (6 hours). Seminars, in small group, will take place in the last days of the semester.
- Field work (9 hours).

1. Regional and land planning.
2. Regional and land plans: legal and technical aspects.
3. Urban system in regional planning.
4. Infrastructures and relational system in regional planning.
