4.1.Methodological overview

All the Geography students are required to write a dissertation, based on an individual choice of topic. The learning and teaching methodology developed is designed to help the students to choose and define their research aims, to select appropriate methods and techniques for the research, and to write up the analysis and interpretation of the findings in a logical and well-structured document supported by references to the relevant academic literature.

The students work under the supervision of at least one supervisor. By the end of the research period, a written document of at least 7,000 words must be prepared according the following structure:

- Introduction
- Background and state of the art

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- Objectives and Methodology
- Analytical Development
- Conclusions
- List of sources, bibliography and used resources

4.2.Learning tasks

The course includes the following learning tasks:

1) General activities for all the students

- Initial briefing (first week of December): The students and their supervisors are informed of the whole process leading to the preparation and presentation of the dissertation.
- Progress seminar (at the beginning of the second semester): One or two sessions will be organised for students who wish to present the rationale and progress of their work. The presentations will be short in order to facilitate the participation and the subsequent discussion.

2) Individual activities

- Regular guidance and monitoring sessions with the supervisor (22.5 hours)
- Preparation of the dissertation (150 hours)

3) Oral presentation (2.5 hours)
