4.1.Methodological overview

The methodology followed in this course is oriented towards achievement of the learning objectives. A wide range of teaching and learning tasks are implemented, such as:

1. Each student will choose the modality and theme for the undergraduate dissertation based on the offer made by the Center. This offer will be updated every year.
2. Seminars. The supervisor will provide the students the necessary guidance for carrying out the dissertation.
3. Tutorials. The students will have at least 4 hours where the supervisor will guide and monitor their work.
4. Individual and autonomous work. The students elaborate their dissertation individually.

4.2.Learning tasks

Each student will choose a topic for his/her dissertation from one of the available research lines.
