## 4.1. Methodological overview

The methodology followed in this course is oriented towards achievement of the learning objectives. A wide range of teaching and learning tasks are implemented, such as:

- 1. Each student will choose the modality and theme for the undergraduate dissertation based on the offer made by the Center. This offer will be updated every year.
- 2. Seminars. The supervisor will provide the students the necessary guidance for carrying out the dissertation.
- 3. Tutorials. The students will have at least 4 hours where the supervisor will guide and monitor their work.
- 4. Individual and autonomous work. The students elaborate their dissertation individually.

### 4.2.Learning tasks



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The course (6 ECTS: 150 hours) includes the following learning tasks:

- Seminars (0.04 ECTS: 1 hour).
- Tutorials (0.20 ECTS: 5 hours).
- Individual work (5.74 ECTS: 143.5 hours).
- Final assessment (0.03 ECTS: 0.5 hours).

## 4.3.Syllabus

Each student will choose a topic for his/her dissertation from one of the available research lines.

## 4.4. Course planning and calendar

Schedule of basic activities under the supervisor's guidance:

- Determining your topic, scope and purpose.
- Planning individual tutorials.
- Progress reports (draft revisions).
- Final editing and proofreading. The final version of the Dissertation will be handed in to the supervisor at least two weeks before the deadline for official submission.
