4.1.Methodological overview

The learning process that has been designed for this subject is based on the following:

The subject presents different methodological strategies to develop the assigned competences. The combination of learning activities will have as a main characteristic the search for an emancipation methodology so that students can acquire competences with autonomy and solvency.

Different work spaces will be combined, such as the classroom, the teaching office and the sports facilities. In turn, different strategies will be developed as a theoretical class, group participatory techniques, group and individual academic tutoring and motor practice activities.

- Theoretical class (1 ECTS: 25 hours)

- Tutorials and exams: (0.2 ECTS: 5 hours)
- Personal study: (1.8 ECTS: 45 hours)

- Block 2. Curricular design, programming and teaching action of Physical Education in Early Childhood Education.
- Block 3. Teaching action in Physical Education in Early Childhood Education
- Block 4. Development of the contents of Physical Education in Early Childhood Education and its activities.
- Block 5: Motor skills from 0 to 3 years. Consequences in the organization of spaces, materials and accompaniment of the teacher in this stage.
