#### 4.1.Methodological overview

Different teaching methods will be used in the process of teaching and learning of this subject. In the case of the lectures, expository teaching methods will be made, although they may use other didactic teaching methods seeking the involvement of students in the teaching-learning process. This second type of methods both favor interaction between teacher and student and among students themselves, and are suitable methods for the development of generic skills.

#### 4.2.Learning tasks

The course includes the following learning tasks:

- Lectures: will use essentially the magisterial lesson to present the contents of the course.
- Practice sessions: can implement the knowledge acquired in the Lectures and demonstrate the ability to work in group and interpersonal communication skills. The development of practice sessions will be based on the use of the case method and solving exercises. However, you can also use other teaching methods such as analysis and discussion of readings in class.
- Individual tutorials in the office: allow a more direct and personal support to students to explain questions about

course content, guide them in the study and resolution of proposed exercises or cases.

- Visits to companies for students: in order to have a realistic view of what is explained in theory, we try to arrange visits to companies with production plants.
