4.1.Methodological overview

The content of the course will be developed through expository classes. The students will have additional references for each issue in the moodle platform.

The students will be encouraged to search information through complementary references (papers, manuals, etc.) in order to increase their knowledge, and the professor will recommend to all students the use of the library and the Internet when they will work in different case studies.

In the practice lessons, the professor will present videos, documentaries or audio tapes to enhance the students' reflexion. Students will work with short case studies in paper format in the beginning of the course in order to find the processes altered and the specific disturbances. As developments progress in the practice the case studies will be longer and with highest number of processes altered.

Note: In the case of changing the on-site format classes to online format classes because of health security reasons we will be able to do the following adaptations:

1. We will adapt the theoretical and practice classes to an online format (through Google Meet or other platform adopted by Unizar).
2. We will use Moodle as a main way to exchange material. We will add research articles, clinical cases, ppt presentations and links to contents of interest.
3. The tutorials will be conducted through email and/or Google Meet or other platform adopted by Unizar).
