The methodology followed in this course is oriented towards the achievement of the learning objectives. A wide range of teaching and learning tasks are implemented, such as lectures, clinical and preclinical case studies, and clinical practice sessions.

4.2.Learning tasks

This course is organized as follows:

- Assignments. Assignments that will be performed by students and will later present them orally.
- Clinical case studies
- Preclinical practice sessions
- Clinical discussion forum on the web

Given the exceptional situation of the 2020-2021 academic year, the way of carrying out the different learning tasks depends on the availability of physical spaces in the Center. So, the online format will be used, that is, that is to say, in a synchronic telematic system, by which teachers and students will be connected through technologies that allow interaction, such as Google Meet for theoretical and practical classes with the whole group.
