1.1.Aims of the course

- To know and to evaluate the fundamentals of the research in didactics of the artistic expression.
- Access to the specialized information sources and extract the relevant bibliographical references.
- Analyze the most common problems that correspond to the specialty.
- Design, plan and evaluate research proposals on didactics of artistic expression.
- Explore the possibilities and lines of intervention that can be proposed from the field of artistic expression.
- Enhance and develop creative capacity based on the possibilities offered by artistic expression.

1.2.Context and importance of this course in the degree

To offer Knowledge of specific aspects about research in didactics of artistic expression.

1.3.Recommendations to take this course

The participation and follow-up of the subject is fundamental for the good development of the activities and the acquisition of the contents.

The student is expected to become involved in a process of reflection and search for autonomy as a researcher.

2.1.Competences

To know some methodological guidelines of the research in artistic education.

2.2.Learning goals

- Understands the concepts and terminology of the suggested bibliography.
- Analyzes examples of research on various issues relating to the didactics of artistic expression.
- Design a research project related to some of the areas of the didactics of artistic expression

2.3.Importance of learning goals

- Access the field-specific information sources.
- Analyze research problems related to the specialty.
- Identify possible research topics within the didactics of artistic expression.
- Elaborate and design proposals that give answer or solution to the research problem posed.

This subject deals with fundamental elements that facilitate decision making regarding the design of research in didactics of artistic expression.

3. Assessment (1st and 2nd call)

3.1. Assessment tasks (description of tasks, marking system and assessment criteria)

Global evaluation:

E01 - Oral or written global exam: 30%. A theoretical test will be carried out with questions of different typologies where the students demonstrate the acquired knowledge and the capacity to apply them.

E03 - Work on analysis, case resolution and methodological development related to the contents of the subject: 70%
Throughout the course will be carried out various specific work where the theoretical contents will be integrated with practical applications and proposals and designs by the students. These works will be valued by the evidence provided in a didactic folder.

It will be necessary to approve both parts of the evaluation test separately with a minimum of 5 points each.

4. Methodology, learning tasks, syllabus and resources

4.1. Methodological overview

The methodology followed in this course is oriented towards achievement of the learning objectives. A wide range of teaching and learning tasks are implemented.

Students are expected to participate actively in class during the semester.

Both the theoretical and practical activities will be aimed at knowing the state of the research.

* Expository activities (exhibition, debate and content analysis).

- Exhibition - discussion of contents in the group-class.

* Practical activities (development and practical application of the contents).

- Debates, analysis of cases and expositions by the student.

- Seminars.

- Fieldworks.

* Supervised activities (reflective capacity and critical awareness)

- Compulsory readings, research works.

- Search of information by students.

4.2. Learning tasks

The course includes the following learning tasks:

- Lectures: the professor presents theoretical contents.

- Practice sessions: they can involve discussion and presentation of case studies, practical work outside the classroom (field work or visits), and seminars.

- Autonomous work: students do tasks such as autonomous study, reading of the course book, preparation of practice sessions and seminars, and summative assignments.

- Tutorials: professor's office hours can be used to solve doubts and to follow-up students' work.

- Assessment: final examination.
