4.1. Methodological overview

The methodology followed in this course is oriented towards the achievement of the learning objectives.

Guided professional practice (assistance and / or administration and / or management), carried out in in-hospital clinics, out-of-hospital, primary and community care, health centers and other settings.

TUTORED CLINICAL PRACTICE: 28 ECTS

SEMINARS: 1.5 ECTS

NON-PRESENTIAL WORK: 12.5 ECTS

4.2. Learning tasks

The program offered to the student to help him achieve the expected results comprises the following activities.

The student will carry out face-to-face practices in the agreed care centers, computing a total of 5 hours daily clinical practice. Throughout the academic year there will be 4 rotations:

1. SPECIALIZED CARE HOSPITAL
2. PRIMARY CARE CENTER
3. NEUROMOTIVE CARE CENTERS
4. MONOGRAPHIC CENTERS

4.3. Syllabus

The course will address the following topics:

During the scholastic year, from October to May, seminars will be given involving topics related to the different health care areas covered by physiotherapists' professional performance:

- Physiotherapy in primary health care.
- Physiotherapy in specialized health care (hospitals).

- Physiotherapy in accident insurance companies.
- Physiotherapy in the education system.
- Physiotherapy in children's cerebral palsy.
- Physiotherapy in geriatric centres.
- Physiotherapy in social services.
- Physiotherapy in sport.
- Physiotherapy in intensive care units.
- Ergonomics applied to physiotherapists' work.
- Workshops for patients' caregivers.

In the second term, students are expected to present clinical sessions, either in the classroom or in the centers where they are taking their practical lessons. The topics are chosen by each student, as long as it is related to any of the health care areas.

4.4. Course planning and calendar

The activities are carried out in the healthcare centers during the course, divided into the following rotations:

MODULE 1: SEPTEMBER TO NOVEMBER

MODULE 2: NOVEMBER TO JANUARY

MODULE 3: FEBRUARY TO MARCH

MODULE 4: MARCH TO MAY

The teaching period runs from September to May.

The assignment of students to healthcare centers will be published on the notice board and on the website of the University well in advance.
