4.1. Methodological overview

The methodology followed in this course is oriented towards the achievement of the learning objectives. A wide range of teaching and learning tasks are implemented, such as lectures, practice sessions and autonomous work.

Students are expected to participate actively in the class throughout the semester.

Classroom materials will be available via Moodle. These include a repository of the lecture notes used in class.

Further information regarding the course will be provided on the first day of class.

4.2. Learning tasks

This is a 6 ECTS course organized as follows:

- **Lectures** (0.5 ECTS: 10 hours). Whole group sessions of 50 minutes each one. The professor will explain the theoretical contents, which are available in advance on the virtual platform Moodle.
- Practice sessions (2 ECTS: 50 hours). Sessions where students practice technical procedures in laboratory.
- Autonomous work (3.5 ECTS: 90 hours). Time devoted to study the course contents and prepare the sessions
 and assignments.

4.3. Syllabus

Lectures

I. Physical Therapy procedures in obstetrics and urogynecological dysfunctions

- 1.- Conceptual framework for physical therapy in pelvic floor dysfunctions and alterations in pelvic statics.
- 2.- Physical Therapy examination of abdomen-pelvic-perineal region.
- 3.- Physcial Therapy procedures in obstetrics and urogynecological dysfunctions:

- Manual therapy
- Instrumental techniques
- Active cinesitherapy for abdomen-pelvic-perineal region.
- Behavioral techniques

II. Physcial therapy in chronic pain

- 1.- Primary chronic pain: central sensibilization mechanisms.
- 2.- Neurocognitives procedure: Perfetti's method, graduated motor imagery, gradual exposure.

III. Physical Therapy in static and dynamics dysfunctions:

- 1. Physical Therapy procedures in spinal deformities.
- 2. Orthopedics in spinal deformities.
- 3. Orthopedcis and physical therapy procedures in extremities.

Practice sessions:

- I. Physical Therapy procedures in obstetrics and urogynecological dysfunctions
- 1.- Physical Therapy examination of abdomen-pelvic-perineal region.
- 2.- Physcial Therapy procedures in obstetrics and urogynecological dysfunctions:
 - Manual therapy: perineal massage, joint and muscle procedures in pelvic region.
- Instrumental techniques: biofeedback, electric-stimulation, orthesis, kinesiotaping, trigger points treatment, vibrators, pessary, dilator, incontinence tampon.
- Active cinesitherapy for abdomen-pelvic-perineal regionl: lumbar-pelvic stabilitation, hypopressive exercies, pilates, fitball .
 - Behavioral techniques: voiding calendar, hyperpressure mechanism correction.

II. Physcial therapy in chronic pain

- Neurocognitives procedure: Perfetti's method, graduated motor imagery
- Neurodinamics level 3.
- III. Physical Therapy in static and dynamics dysfunctions:
 - Physical Therapy procedures in spinal deformities.
 - Orthopedics in spinal deformities.
 - Orthopedcis and physical therapy procedures in extremities.
