4.1. Methodological overview

The learning process that has been designed for this subject is based on the following:

In the verification of learning with input of data and in the feedback and academic criticism about the real field of teaching.

4.2. Learning tasks

The program offered to the student to help him achieve the expected results includes the following activities:

A mandatory stay in school for 165 hours of class time. Absences must be made up, including those justified by certificate.

Putting in common, debate and guide of the different activities in the periodic meetings with the tutor of the faculty.

Academic work, where to present the results of their learning during the School Practices, attending to the specified criteria.

Contents of academic work:

Schematic presentation of the classroom context: data such as the level or age of the students and the number, as well as a brief mention of classroom materials and resources. Data will also be included on the Aragonese teaching model implemented in the center and on the sociolinguistic situation of the context in which it is found.

Observation tasks whose guidelines will be administered at the beginning of the course.

Presentation and explanation of the activities that have been developed in coordination with the tutor of the school, as well as those designed or taught by the student himself, specifying the authorship with total clarity. Academic and critical opinion based on the existing or non-existent relationship between school practice and subjects theoretical-practical studies studied in the Aragonese Language Mention.

Reflection and self-evaluation on the student's own performance in the classroom and the learning achieved.

Academic work format:

The academic work must be presented according to the following form:

It will be written in the Aragonese language.

Any type of font can be used, always in size 12 and with a line spacing of 1.5 points.

The cover must include: name and surname of the student and the faculty tutor, school center and full name of the tutor.

On the first page, the index with the pages corresponding to each chapter.

If citations or bibliographic references are included, it will be done in an academic way.

If books, articles, records, films, websites or educational materials of any kind are cited, all the references in a final section of bibliography and materials, arranged alphabetically by author.

Length: between 3,500 and 4,000 words, excluding the index and bibliography.
It is mandatory to present it in paper format, although no special binding is necessary.
It is also mandatory to send it by email to the tutor of the faculty, in PDF format.
