4.1. Methodological overview

The learning process that has been designed for this subject is based on the following:

- Use of active learning methodologies
- Preparation of a work
- Oral presentation and working debate
- Tutorials

In the verification of learning with input of data and in the feedback and academic criticism about the real field of teaching.

4.2. Learning tasks

The program offered to the student to help him achieve the expected results comprises the following activities ...

1. A mandatory stay in the school for 168 hours of school hours. Absences must be made up, including those justified by certificate.
2. Putting in common, debate and guide of the different activities in the periodic meetings with the tutor of the faculty.
3. Academic work, where he will present the results of his learning during the School Practices III, according to the specified criteria.

CONTENTS OF THE ACADEMIC WORK:

1. Presentation in schematic form of the classroom context: data such as the level or age of the students and the number, as well as a brief mention of the classroom materials and resources.
2. Observation tasks whose guidelines will be administered at the beginning of the subject.
3. Activities that have been developed in coordination with the tutor of the school, as well as those designed or taught by the student, may be presented or explained, specifying the authorship with total clarity.
4. The academic and critical opinion based on the relationship existing or not between school practice and the theoretical-practical subjects studied in the English Language Mention.
5. Reflection and self-evaluation on the student's own performance in the classroom and the learning achieved.

FORMAT OF THE ACADEMIC WORK: The academic work must be presented according to the following form:

- It will be written in English.
- Any type and size of characters can be used, always double-spaced.
- The cover must include: name and surname of the student and of the faculty tutor, school center and full name of the tutor.
- On the first page, the index with the pages corresponding to each chapter.
- If citations or bibliographic references are included, it will be done in an academic way.
- If books, articles, records, films, websites or educational materials of any kind are cited, all references will be collected in a final section of bibliography and materials, arranged alphabetically by author.
- Length: between 3,500 and 4,000 words, excluding the index and bibliography.
- It is mandatory to present it in paper format, although no special binding is necessary.
- It is mandatory to send it by email to the tutor of the faculty, in PDF format.
- The length of the report will be between 30 and 40 pages, without considering the annexes.
- It is also mandatory to send it by email to the tutor of the faculty, in PDF format.

N.B. The European Portfolio for Student Teachers of Languages (EPOSTL) should be borne in mind in all assessment tasks.
