### 4. Methodology, learning tasks, syllabus and resources

#### 4.1. Methodological overview

The methodology followed in this course is oriented towards the achievement of the learning objectives. A wide range of teaching and learning tasks are implemented, such as lectures, seminars, practice sessions, and group work.

#### 4.2. Learning tasks

This course is organized as follows:

- **Lectures:** during the course development, lectures will be held with student participation. Dialogue, questions, and problems will be posed for deeper learning. For the exposition of the topics, PowerPoint presentations will be used.
- **Seminars:** Theory-practice based.
- **Practice sessions:** A compendium of practical activities will be done in the preclinic laboratory. These activities will bring the student closer to the clinic daily basis. Assistance and portfolio presentations are mandatory.
- **Group work:** Several topics will be given by the professor; the student will elaborate an essay based on bibliography and evidence-based dentistry. All the student's homework will have a public presentation.

#### 4.3. Syllabus

This course will address the following topics:

##### **Theory:**

- Topic 1: Fixed prostheses: concept, history, indications, and contraindications. Glossary terms.
- Topic 2: Full metal crowns
- Topic 3: Porcelain fused to metal crowns
- Topic 4: Root retainers
- Topic 5: Full ceramic restorations

- Topic 6: Porcelain types.
- Topic 7: Porcelain veneers
- Topic 8: Bridge design
- Topic 9: Fixed prostheses pontic
- Topic 10: Fixed prostheses connectors
- Topic 11: Gingival retraction. Impression taking
- Topic 12: Transitional prostheses. Provisional rehabilitation.
- Topic 13: Esthetic Analysis: Facial, dentolabial, phonetic and dentogingival analysis.

#### **Practice**

- 1- Tooth preparation: Preparations for metal crowns, porcelain fused to metal crown, and all-ceramic crowns.
- 2- Venner preparations
- 3- Gingival retraction and impression taking
