3. Exercises in pronunciation and listening to texts / conversations.
4. Exercises of writing texts of progressive difficulty.
5. Group conversation activities.
6. New technology activities related to the Arabic language and culture.
7. Outside the classroom, the student must carry out various activities supervised by the teacher aimed at consolidating his language skills.
