4.1. Methodological overview

The learning process designed for this subject is based on the following:

The subject has a basic orientation so that the proposed activities focus on the understanding and assimilation of the main foundations of Social Psychology. The designed sequence of activities includes the following modalities:

Theoretical sessions or lectures: these include lectures as well as the stimulation of students' participation and active learning.

Practice sessions: theoretical knowledge will be applied to real situations and teamwork and cooperative learning will be facilitated.

Office hours: students will be encouraged to use the office hours through various systems and modalities: conventional office hours, more specific office hours related to practical work, and online office hours. This will help to monitor the learning process.

Teaching platform: as support, the platform "Moodle" will be used to consult and download basic and complementary material.

4.2. Learning tasks

The program offered to the student to help him/her achieve the expected results comprises the following activities:

The Program will be developed through the following activities:

Academic sessions: led well by the teacher with the active participation of the students.

- Theory sessions: 30 hours (1.2 ECTS)

- Problem solving and evaluation of specific cases: 20 hours (0.8 ECTS)

Autonomous work: In order to properly comprehend the masterclasses and to be able to work in the practical sessions, both in groups and individually, it is necessary that the student dedicates some time to autonomous work.

- 40 hours work (1.6 ECTS)

- study 50 hours (2 ECTS)

- Evaluation tests 10 hours (0.4 ECTS)
