- 1. Procedure for the assignment of Master's dissertation supervisors mode A The Department will assign a director of TFM A to those students who either have not applied for TFM modality B or who have not been selected to do modality B. The Department will communicate to the Master's coordination the list of students assigned to the different lecturers responsible for the TFM and it will be published on the website.
- 2. Procedure for the assignment of tutors for Master's Thesis modality B Students wishing to carry out mode B of the Master's dissertation must apply for the acceptance of the Master's dissertation supervisor by means of a request addressed to the Master's Quality Assurance Committee. This application must be submitted to the secretary's office of the Faculty of Education.

 1. The student will make the application on the basis of the lists of TFM B proposals published for the different specialisations in the corresponding period.

 2. The student must indicate a maximum of three options in order of preference among those offered.

 3. Once the applications have been received, the coordination of the degree will carry out the allocation according to the offers and applications, deciding in the cases of overlapping applications by means of the academic mark of access. The allocation will be approved by the Quality Assurance Committee.
