### 4. Methodology, learning tasks, syllabus and resources

#### 4.1. Methodological overview

The Practicum I integrates the development of templates for classroom observation, class observation through audiovisual means provided by the assigned tutors, and real classes (which implies knowing the typology of the practice centers and the training plan that it is applied in them), the elaboration of a memory of those activities, and the assessment of them.

#### 4.3. Syllabus

1. Study and prospection of the typology of SFL centres.
2. SFL curriculum: analysis of the different situations in the SFL classroom according to the levels of knowledge, the composition of the class, available means, etc.
3. Observation of SFL classes (according to an observation template adapted to the characteristics of the internship centre and completed by the student).

#### 4.4. Course planning and calendar

1. Practicum I must necessarily be taken before Practicum II.
2. Start date according to the academic calendar. The teacher-tutor will deliver to the students a document with a detailed list of the training activities that will be carried out in the internship centers, in accordance with the provisions of the educational cooperation agreements with those centers. The details of the internship will be signed by the student, the teacher-tutor responsible for the Internship, and the tutor responsible for the internship center before the internship begins.
3. Classroom observation practice sessions. They will be regulated by the academic calendar of the University of Zaragoza and, likewise, the academic calendar of the internship centers must be taken into account.
