4.1. Methodological overview

The methodology followed in this course is oriented towards the achievement of the learning objectives. It is based on active methodologies that favour the development of critical thinking. A wide range of teaching and learning tasks are implemented, such as lectures, practice sessions, autonomous work and assessment tasks.

Students are expected to participate actively in the class throughout the semester.

Classroom materials will be available via Moodle. These include a repository of the lecture notes used in class, the course syllabus, as well as other course-specific learning materials, including a discussion forum.

4.2. Learning tasks

This is a 6 ECTS course organized as follows:

2. The teaching of the diatopic varieties of Spanish. Spanish in the world. Dialectal areas. Main characteristics of Spanish in

Spain and Spanish in America. The «International Spanish». Diatopic variation in the ELE classroom.

3. Teaching the diastratic varieties of Spanish. Socio-cultural strata or levels. Diastratic variation in the ELE classroom.

4. Teaching the diaphasic varieties of Spanish. Variation in use and communicative situations. Main characteristic features of colloquial Spanish. Diaphasic variation in the ELE class.
