### 4. Methodology, learning tasks, syllabus and resources

#### 4.1. Methodological overview

The methodology followed in this course is oriented towards the achievement of the learning objectives. It is based on active methodologies that favour the development of critical thinking. A wide range of teaching and learning tasks are implemented, such as lectures, practice sessions, autonomous work and assessment tasks.

Students are expected to participate actively in the class throughout the semester.

Classroom materials will be available via Moodle. These include a repository of the lecture notes used in class, the course syllabus, as well as other course-specific learning materials, including a discussion forum.

#### 4.2. Learning tasks

This is a 6 ECTS course organized as follows:

? Lectures (30 hours).

? Practice sessions (30 hours). Students are expected to use ICTs for their assignments and create documents individually and collaboratively.

? Autonomous work (15 hours).

#### 4.3. Syllabus

The course will address the following topics:

1. Criteria for the analysis of materials for SFL training.

2. Introduction, analysis and contrast of materials for SFL of diverse methodological approaches (Grammar-translation method, Direct method, Structural approaches, Communicative language teaching, Input processing instruction).

3. Creation of SFL materials: guidelines and experimentation. Language skills: oral and written expression, comprehension and interaction.

4. Use of ICT to create one's teaching materials.
