4.2. Learning tasks

The Clinical Nursing II subject, with a course load of 6 ECTS, is structured through the following learning activities:

-Theoretical or master classes: They are given to the two large groups of theory of the subject with the active participation of the students in the development of the classes. Number of student hours 30.

-Laboratory practices: Attendance and participation is mandatory, you can only miss a practical session to be evaluated. They are taught in a small group, whose composition and structure is determined by the teaching organization of the 2nd year of the Degree in Nursing at the Faculty of Health Sciences of Zaragoza, in order for the student to have the technical and collaborative skills of the most relevant nursing processes that are reflected in the practical program. Number of student hours 25.

-Resolution of problems and cases. Sessions where students work with cases and problem solving tasks. Number of student hours 5.

-Individual study of the student. Time dedicated to studying the contents of the course and preparing the topics and cases. Number of hours 84.

-Evaluation. Number of student hours 6.

4.3. Syllabus

-Theory program contents:

Section 1.

Topic. Auditive System. Anatomical-physiological memory, Assessment, Techniques and Nursing Process in the main diseases of the auditory system

Topic. Integumentary system. Anatomical-physiological memory, Assessment, Techniques and Nursing Process in the main diseases of the integumentary system

Section 2.

Topic. Visual system. Anatomical-physiological memory, Assessment, Techniques and Nursing Process in the main diseases of the visual system, as well as the ocular complications caused by diabetes mellitus.

Topic. Respiratory system. Anatomical-physiological memory, Assessment, Techniques and Nursing Process in the main diseases of the respiratory system.

-Contents program resolution problems and cases:

Problems and cases presented by teachers to students related to the contents of modules 1 and 2 of the theory program.

-Contents of the laboratory practical program:

1. Ear examination:

-Otoscopy.

-Removal of earwax plug.

-Vestibular alteration.

-Role playing.

2. Burns:

-Calculation of the burned area affected. Parkland rule.

-Form of administration of the treatment in the burned patient.

3. Eye care:

-Basic eye care techniques.

-Clinic on ocular pathologies.

-Gamification.

4. Nursing care in patients with upper airway obstruction:

-FBAO (Foreign Body Airway Obstruction)

-Guidelines for action in the FBAO.

4.4. Course planning and calendar

Planning of teaching activities. In the planning of the subject, the following three aspects have been taken into account; the first aspect is the existence of two groups in the course, the second aspect is the annual nature of the subject. and the third and last aspect is the modular distribution of teaching (one group receives theoretical teaching, while the other group receives clinical practice teaching alternatively).

The planning of teaching activities is based on the academic organization document of the Nursing Degree of the Faculty of Health Sciences, which reflects the calendar of the academic planning of the subject in the academic year 2022-23, insofar as to dates of theoretical-practical classes, schedule and number of groups.

Exam dates:

Partial exams: The dates of the partial tests on the date and time will be determined once the subject has been taught. The

dates for these tests will be chosen through prior information and communication with the students.

Final exam: The final exams for June and July 2023 will be held on the dates indicated in the official examination schedule for the Degree in Nursing, which can be consulted on the website of the Faculty of Health Sciences of the University of Zaragoza.
