4.1. Methodological overview

The learning process designed for this subject is based on the following:

Active student participation. Students will be introduced to the criteria of participation, active learning and critical attitude. Students will be given a margin of initiative in the selection of readings and topics for practical work. Periodically, the texts to be read before the classroom sessions will be indicated in order to enrich the classroom debates.

4.4. Course planning and calendar

Global written test:

It will be carried out in the official exam on the theoretical content of the subject.
