4.1. Methodological overview

The methodology followed in this course is oriented towards the achievement of the learning objectives. It is based on active participation, case studies, teamwork, etc., that favor the development of communicative skills, and critical thinking about History of Law. A wide range of teaching and learning tasks are implemented, such as lectures, practice sessions, autonomous work, tutorials and assessment tasks.

Students are expected to participate actively in the class throughout the semester. Classroom materials will be available via Moodle. These include a repository of the lecture notes used in class, the course syllabus, as well as other course-specific learning materials.

Further information regarding the course will be provided on the first day of class.

4.2. Learning tasks

This is a 6 ECTS course organized as follows:

Lectures (1 ECTS: 20 hours). The teacher presents theoretical contents illustrated with relevant examples.

Practice sessions (1 ECTS: 20 hours). They can include discussion and presentation of case studies, practical work outside the classroom (field work or visits), and seminars.

Autonomous work (1 ECTS: 20 hours). Students do tasks such as study, readings, preparation of practice sessions and seminars, and summative assignments.

Tutorials (0.5 ECTS: 5 hours). Office hours can be used to solved doubts and for follow-up of students? learning progress.

Assessment tasks (0.5 ECTS: 5 hours). A final written examination.

4.3. Syllabus

The course will address the following topics: Spanish Law

- Topic 0. Introduction and objectives. Organization.
- Topic 1. From the Beginning to the Fifth Century BC : From Iberia to Spain. The integration of Spain in the Roman World.
- Topic 2. Fifth to Eighth Centuries: Goths: The formation of the Visigoth Spanish Kingdom and the sources of Law.
- Topic 3. Eighth Centuries: High Middle Ages. The Law of the Christian Kingdoms.
- Topic 4. Thirteenth Century: Transformations in Late Middle Ages: *Ius Comune* and National Law.
- Topic 5. Fourteenth and Fifteenth Centuries: The institutionalization of Kingdoms and Crowns.
- Topic 6. Sixteenth and Seventeenth Centuries: The Hispanic Empire.
- Topic 7. Eighteenth Century: From the Hispanic Empire to the Kingdom of Spain.
- Topic 8. Nineteenth and Twentieth Centuries: The Constitutional Spain (1808-1978).
