A wide range of teaching and learning tasks are implemented, such as practice sessions, autonomous work, etc.

Students are expected to participate actively in the class throughout the semester.

4.2. Learning tasks

This is a 6 ECTS course organized as follows:

- ? **Autonomous work:** Students do tasks such as study, readings, preparation of practice sessions and seminars, and summative assignments.

- ? Assessment tasks: A final written examination.
