## 4.1. Methodological overview

The course will be developed on the basis of the presentation of theoretical-practical topics, presented in class in French by the teacher, and group and individual work by the students, delivered orally or in writing

Further information regarding the course will be provided on the first day of class.

#### 4.2. Learning tasks

This is a 6 ECTS course, which will be developed on the basis of the presentation of theoretical and practical topics, presented in class in French by the teacher, and group and individual work by the students, delivered orally or in writing:

- Lectures, in which the students are introduced to the basic theoretical knowledge of the subject.
- Practical classes, which will consist of analysis, commentary and interpretation of selected literary fragments.
- Individual work: proposal and selection of themes, orientation and bibliographical information.
- Group work: proposal and selection of topics, guidance and bibliographical information
- Tutorials: monitoring of tasks related to the assignments and resolution of doubts

#### 4.3. Syllabus

The course will address the following topics:

- 1. Aesthetic movements in the 17th century. Poetry from preciosity to classicism.
- 2. The evolution of narrative genres.
- 3. The ?Querelles? and the formation of classical theatre.
