Topic 1: History, concept, research methodology.

Topic 4: Mood stabilizers.

Topic 5: Biological bases of anxiety and anxiolytics.

Topic 6: Biological bases and pharmacological treatment for panic disorder, OCD, phobias and PTSD.

Topic 7: Hypnotics.

Topic 8: Biological bases of schizophrenia and other psychoses, antipsychotics and neuroleptics.

Topic 9: Psychopharmacology of substances of abuse.

Topic 10: Biological bases of the Tr. Cognitive and cognitive enhancers/neuroprotective agents.
