4.1. Methodological overview

MIDAP is taught in virtual mode, a fact that will allow access to the degree to those who, due to their location, professional or personal reasons, find it difficult to attend the subject in person. It is proposed to approach the study of the subject critically, both from the revision of the legal texts and of doctrine.

Personalized attention

The teachers will personally attend the students both in person (during the hours established tutoring), as virtual (email or videoconferencing).
