PROCEDURE FOR THE ASSIGNMENT OF MASTER'S THESIS TUTORS (MODALITY A)

The departments responsible for the teaching of Practicum II and III, corresponding to the different specialities of the Master, will assign a TFM A tutor to those students who either have not applied for TFM modality B or who have not been selected to do modality B. The departments will inform the Master's Coordination of the list of students assigned to the different lecturers responsible for the TFM and it will be published on the website.

PROCEDURE FOR APPLYING FOR THE MASTER'S THESIS (MODALITY B)

Students wishing to undertake mode B of the Master's dissertation must apply for acceptance of the direction of the Master's dissertation by means of an application addressed to the Master's Degree Quality Assurance Committee (ANNEX II. Initial application for the Master's dissertation). This application must be submitted to the secretary's office of the faculty or school (Faculty of Education, Faculty of Humanities and Education and Faculty of Social and Human Sciences).

The student will make the application on the basis of the lists of TFM B proposals published for the different specialisations in the corresponding period.

The student must indicate a maximum of three options in order of preference among those offered.

Once the applications have been received, the degree coordinator will carry out the allocation according to the offers and applications, deciding in the cases of overlapping applications by means of the grade of the access academic. The allocation will be approved by the Quality Assurance Committee.

The list of students assigned to the TFM B lines will be communicated to the teaching staff and will be published on the website.
