PROCEDURE FOR THE ASSIGNMENT OF WORK TUTORS END OF MASTER'S DEGREE (MODALITY A)

The department responsible for teaching Practicum II for the specialty of Physics and Chemistry,

Didactics of Experimental Sciences, will assign a TFM tutor to each student. The Department

will communicate to the Coordination of the Master the list of students assigned to the different professors

responsible for the TFM and will be published on the web.

PROCEDURE FOR THE APPLICATION FOR THE MASTER'S DEGREE PROJECT (MODALITY B)

The student who wishes to carry out modality B of the TFM will request the acceptance of direction of the TFM through instance addressed to the Master's Quality Assurance Commission (ANNEX II. Initial Job Application End of Master). This request must be submitted to the Secretary of the Faculty of Education.

1. The student will make the request from the lists of TFM B proposals published within the deadline correspondent.
2. The student must indicate a maximum of three options in order of preference among those offered.
3. Once the applications have been received, the coordinator of the degree will make the assignment according to the offers and requests, deciding in the cases of coincident requests by means of the note of the academic of access. The award will be approved by the Quality Assurance Commission.
4. The list of students assigned to the TFM B lines will be communicated to the faculty and will be published in the web.
