PROCEDURE FOR ASSIGNING MASTER'S THESIS TUTORS (MODALITY A)

The department corresponding to the Master's speciality will assign a TFM A tutor to those students who either have not applied for the TFM modality B or have not been selected to do modality B. The departments will inform the Master's Coordination of the list of students assigned to the different lecturers responsible for the TFM, which will subsequently be published on the degree's website.

PROCEDURE FOR APPLYING FOR THE MASTER'S THESIS (MODALITY B)

Students wishing to undertake mode B of the Master's dissertation must apply for acceptance of the direction of the Master's dissertation by means of a request addressed to the Master's Degree Quality Assurance Committee (Annex II. Initial application for the Master's dissertation). This application must be submitted to the secretary's office of the centre (Faculty of Education, Faculty of Humanities and Education and Faculty of Social and Human Sciences).

1. The student will make the application on the basis of the lists of TFM B proposals published for the different specialisations in the corresponding period.
2. The student must indicate a maximum of three options in order of preference among those offered.
3. Once the applications have been received, the coordination of the degree programme will carry out the allocation according to the offers and applications, deciding in the cases of coinciding applications by means of the average mark of access to the degree programme. The allocation will be approved by the Quality Assurance Committee.
4. The list of students assigned to the TFM B lines will be communicated to the teaching staff and subsequently published on the degree's website.

The approach, methodology and assessment of this guide is prepared to be the same in any teaching scenario. They will be adjusted to the socio-sanitary conditions of each moment, as well as to the indications given by the competent authorities.
