4.1. Methodological overview

In the case of Modalidad A, more precise guidelines will be provided in a group briefing at the beginning of the course. Subsequently, each student must contact the assigned tutor who will monitor the Dissertation. In the case of Modalidad B, the tutor will provide adequate guidelines depending on the type of Dissertation.

The organization of seminars by invited speakers in order to facilitate the acquisition of the competences of the subject will be considered.

Students who completed the Master in courses prior to the course prior to the present and have not started working on their Dissertation or have not advanced significantly, must carry out complementary learning activities, which will consist of the directed reading of bibliography and the writing of a critical analysis of materials that will serve as a starting point for the Master's Final Project of Modalidad A. PROCEDURE FOR THE APPLICATION FOR MODALIDAD B

The student who wishes to carry out this type of Dissertation will request it to the Quality Commission of the Master's Degree ([ANEXO II. Solicitud inicial de Trabajo Fin de Máster](#)) at the Faculty of Education Administration Office

1. The Department will offer a number of research lines
2. The student will indicate a maximum of three options in order of preference among those offered
3. Once the applications have been received, the general coordinator will assign a research line, deciding in the cases of coincident applications through the grade of access. This will be approved by the Quality Commission.
4. The assignment will be communicated to the Dissertation supervisor and published on the web.
