Attempts will be made to create environments that favour the communicative dimension; encouraging debate and the active participation of students in the daily development of class work and promoting interaction between students and teachers, and among students. Inquiry and the expression of students' conceptions will be facilitated at all times, and constant reflection will be encouraged.
