#### 2.2. Learning goals

The student, to pass this subject, must demonstrate the following results:

1. Identify the contents that are worked on in the classroom during the internship period, relating them to the cycle schedules and to the official curricular documents.
2. Describe the characteristics of the students and the class, understood as a formative and social group, the didactic strategies used by the teacher and the main teaching-learning problems that he encounters in his class.
3. Identify the learning difficulties of the students, analyzing their causes and establishing implications for the teaching process.
4. Design, implement and evaluate didactic sequences that are based on explicit principles of teaching and learning and that incorporate elements of didactic innovation, and propose improvements based on the analysis of experience.
5. Use adequately the expressions and the specific vocabulary of the educational field and the corresponding curricular subjects.

#### 4.1. Methodological overview

The learning process that has been designed for this subject is based on the following:

- Integration of previously acquired knowledge and competences.
- Observation, analysis and implementation of teaching procedures.
- Observation, analysis and implementation of assessment, innovation or educational research

methodologies.

- Analysis, elaboration and use of didactic materials for learning at secondary education levels, both general and special.
- Assessment of one's own teaching practice with a view to continuous improvement.
- Experimentation with different procedures suggested by tutors.

#### **4.2. Learning tasks**

The programme offered to the student to help him/her achieve the expected results comprises the following activities:

- At the work placement centre, attendance at the classes and meetings set up with their tutor. They will attend the classes corresponding to their speciality, observe the work methodology, the materials available and the specific development of the classes. They will be familiar with all the training levels where subjects of their speciality are taught in the centre and the institutional programmes existing in it.
- Design of the materials to be used in the teaching-learning activities to be carried out with the students at their placement centre.
- Discussion and debate seminars. Discussion with colleagues in their own speciality regarding the applications of the activities, as well as the materials foreseen.
- Regular meetings with the lecturer and other students in the group to analyse and discuss the Practicum experience.
