1. Procedure for the assignment of tutors of End of Master's Thesis modality A

The specialty coordinator will assign a director of TFM A to those students who either have not taken up TFM modality B or have not been selected to carry out modality B. The specialty coordinator will notify the coordination General of the Master of the list of students assigned to the different professors responsible for the TFM and will be published on the web.

2. Procedure for the assignment of tutors of Final Master's Thesis, modality B

The student who wishes to carry out the modality B of the TFM will request the acceptance of the TFM management using a request addressed to the Master's Quality Assurance Commission. Said instance must be presented at the secretariat of the Faculty of Education.

The student will make the application from the TFM B proposal lists published for the different specialties in the corresponding period.

The student must indicate a maximum of three options in order of preference among those offered.

Once the applications are received, the degree coordination will carry out the assignment according to the offers and

requests, deciding in the cases of coincident applications through the academic access grade. The award will be approved by the Quality Assurance Commission.
The list of students assigned to the TFM B lines will be communicated to the teaching staff and will be published on the web.
