4.1. Methodological overview

The learning process that has been designed for this subject is based on the following:

For each of the placements in the collaborating entities, a Training Project will be designed, which will have to be completed under the supervision of the tutor assigned by the collaborating entity. The student will have to produce a final report at the end of the placement.

Each student will also be assigned an academic tutor who will ensure compliance with the Training Project and will be available to the student at the University.

It will be necessary to sign an agreement with the collaborating entities.

4.2. Learning tasks

The programme offered to the student to help him/her achieve the expected results comprises the following activities activities...

- Student work in companies, professional offices, administrations and institutions. Methodology: Active participation in professional work in a work context.
- Student's work for the preparation and elaboration of documents and papers. Methodology: Study of theoretical and practical contents and preparation of activities.
- Tutorials, through the interaction and activity of the student with the teacher.
- Evaluation activities, tests carried out by the student on the acquisition of competences.

4.3. Syllabus

The subject does not have a syllabus as such.

4.4. Course planning and calendar

Master Coordinator will publish the necessary timetable for the fulfilment of the learning objectives of the course. The key dates will be posted on the Faculty's website and, where appropriate, in the ADD.

The allocation of places offered by the Faculty will be based on the average mark of the academic transcript, using the same criteria as for the previous enrolment appointment.

Exceptionally, it is possible to carry out external internships in offices or companies located by the student him/herself (self-practicals), which must meet the same requirements as those offered by the Faculty.
