1. General information

It is a guided professional practice (assistance and/or administration and/or management), carried out in clinics, in-hospital, out-of-hospital, primary and community care, social-health centres and other settings.

Its main objective is that the student demonstrates the acquisition of the necessary professional competencies to successfully integrate into the labour market.

These approaches and objectives are aligned with the following Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) of the United Nations Agenda 2030 (<https://www.un.org/sustainabledevelopment/es/>), in such a way that the acquisition of the learning results of the subject provides training and competence to contribute to some extent to the achievement of Goal 3 (health and well-being), Goal 10 (reducing inequalities), Goal 17 (Partnerships to achieve the goals).

2. Learning results

The student, in order to pass this subject, must demonstrate the following results...

To know and understand the methods, procedures and physiotherapeutic actions, aimed both at the actual therapy to apply in the clinic for the re-education or functional recovery, as well as to the realization of activities aimed at the promotion and maintenance of health.

To acquire adequate clinical experience that provides intellectual abilities and technical and manual skills; that facilitates the incorporation of ethical and professional values; and that develops the ability to integrate the knowledge acquired so that, at the end of their studies, students will be able to apply them to specific clinical cases in the hospital and outpatient setting, as well as to actions in primary and community care.

3. Syllabus

During the second four-month period of the academic year, from January to May, two modules will be organized in which the student will carry out a total of 6 hours of clinical practice per day in the agreed health care centres.

4. Academic activities

The program offered to the student to help them achieve the expected results comprises the following activities:

The student will perform face-to-face practices in the agreed health care centres, with a total of 6 hours of clinical practice per day. During the academic year, 2 rotations will be performed in one of these areas:

1. SPECIALTY CARE HOSPITAL
2. PRIMARY CARE CENTER
3. NEUROMOTOR CARE CENTERS
4. MONOGRAPHIC CENTERS

5. Assessment system

The student must demonstrate that they have achieved the expected learning results through the evaluation of the clinical practice, distributed in two modules.

The tutor of the care centre directs and supervises the student's work. Their daily observations of the activity, records, interviews or tests serve to assess the aspects related to the fulfilment of the Practicum activities.

Each of the two clinical practice rotations is evaluated independently. At the end of each rotation the student must submit a brief REPORT, which is a prerequisite for evaluation.

The grade for each of the rotations is from 0 to 10 points. The final grade for the subject is the average of these two evaluations. It is a requirement to pass (5 or more points) each of the internship rotations.
