1. General information

The External Internships I and II constitute the Practicum of the Degree in Occupational Therapy.

These two subjects, together with the Degree Final Project, make up the Teaching Integration Module.

1.1. Objectives

That the student demonstrates the acquisition of the necessary professional competences (knowledge, know how to be, know how to do and know how to be) to be able to integrate into the labour market with guarantees of success.

These approaches and objectives are aligned with the following Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) of the United Nations Agenda 2030 (https://www.un.org/sustainabledevelopment/es/), so that the acquisition of the learning results of the subject provides training and knowledge, skills and competencies to contribute to some extent to their achievement. 2. Learning results

- 1- Work adequately in a team developing general and specific competences of this profession in the following fields:
 - · Physical disability usually in acute/subacute phase, of diverse aetiology.
 - Gerontology/geriatrics, in a holistic manner, attending to individual and group needs.
 - Physical and/or psychic disability in chronic phase of diverse aetiology (Acquired Brain Damage, Parkinson's disease, Multiple Sclerosis, Cerebral Palsy, Intellectual Disability).
 - Psychiatry and/or psychosocial care in subacute or chronic phase, of diverse aetiology (severe mental disorder, personality, bipolar, schizophrenia, homeless, etc.) with a predominance of adulthood.
- 2- Apply the theoretical and methodological foundations, assessments and techniques of occupational therapy within the rehabilitation service in the hospital, in gerontology/geriatrics in the home environment, hospital, day center and geriatric residence, in physical and/or psychic disability in chronic phase in monographic centres, as well as in the psychosocial/psychiatry field in the home, hospital, day center and nursing home environment.

3. Syllabus

The learning process that has been designed for this subject is based on the realization of the following activities:

- · Clinical/assistance practice.
- Seminars.
- · Individual and/or very small group tutoring.
- Individual work: activity diary and internship report.

The development of the subject is organized in 2 modules:

FIRST MODULE (September to November)

THIRD MODULE (February to March)

4. Academic activities

Clinical/assistance practice: 325 h distributed in two modules, in the following practice areas:

· Physical rehabilitation

- Psychiatry/Psychosocial
- · Gerontology/Geriatrics
- Monographic centres

Seminars: 12,5h. To be held in the first quarter (September or October)

Tutoring: 12,5h

Autonomous work: 50h

- · Activity diary. It should be submitted weekly to the teacher/assistant tutor in the corresponding area.
- Internship report. It must be handed in to the teacher/tutor at the end of the first and third modules.

5. Assessment system

The evaluation will be carried out by the teacher/assistant tutor of the internship destination and the evaluation notebook will be sent to the external internship coordinator.

- The **competencies** acquired will be evaluated and will account for 70% of the final grade. The competences to be acquired according to the Report` Verified by ANECA of the Degree in Occupational Therapy can be consulted in the Manual of Curricular External Practices of the Degree in Occupational Therapy, available in: https://fcs.unizar.es/grado-en-terapia-ocupacional-0
- The weekly diary corresponds to 15% of the final grade.
- The final report corresponds to the remaining 15%.
