1. General information

This subject allows the student to put into practice the knowledge acquired throughout the Degree by means of their insertion in a company or institution, introducing them to the exercise of professional activity.

2. Learning results

4. Academic activities

External internships are regulated by Royal Decree 592/2014, of July 11 and by the Resolution of November 30, 2012 of the Rector of Unizar, on external academic internships, to which reference is made.

The tutor appointed by the entity must have professional experience. Submit a final report including the number of internship hours and any other aspects considered appropriate

The student must: conduct an orientation interview with the academic tutor and internship tutor, work at the agreed center, carry out follow-up tutorials and submit an internship report.
