2. Learning results

The student, in order to pass this subject, must demonstrate the following results...

- Solve communicative situations, simulations and case studies in French that involve the understanding of fundamental concepts of the subject.

4. Academic activities

5. Assessment system

First call:

Global evaluation consisting of the following tests:

- 1) Test with questions corresponding to the grammatical, lexical and discursive contents of the subject (20%).
- 2) Listening comprehension test (20%)
- 3) Written comprehension test (25%)
- 4) Oral test (35% of the final grade) consisting of a monologue and an interaction.

Assessment criteria:

- -Fluency.
- Pronunciation.
- The use of specific vocabulary appropriate to the communication situation.
- Comprehension of different types of documents and oral situations.
- Spelling and grammatical correctness
