#### 1. General information

The External Practices course (PEXT) is carried out in a unit, center or organization of the Army or the Ministry of Defence, during the same period in which the student develops the Final Degree Project (TFG) subject. The objective is to shape the 18 credits that result from adding PEXT and TFG into a coherent training activity, which at the same time that meets all university academic requirements, provides the best performance in the training of future officers of the Army.

The course and its expected outcomes are intended to give the student an introduction to the field in which he/she will have to develop his/her profession and to the functions he/she will have to perform in his/her first jobs the field in which he/she will have to develop his/her profession and the functions he/she will have to perform in his/her first jobs.

## 3. Syllabus

The subjects of External Practices (PEXT) and Final Degree Project (TFG) are taken in the first semester of the fifth year semester of the fifth year and are articulated in a face-to-face phase of eight weeks during the months of September and October September and October.

The student will have:

- A Military Director (DIRMIL) in the PEXT unit, center or agency, who will perform the functions of the military director of the TFG and may also be the PEXT tutor military director of the TFG and may, in turn, be the PEXT tutor.
- An Academic Director (DIRACA) of the CUD, who will act both as academic tutor of the PEXT, as well as academic
  director of the TFG the PEXT, as well as the academic director of their TFG.

The program of activities for externships will be proposed by your Military Director (DIRMIL), and supervised by the Academic Director (DIRACA) supervised by the Academic Director (DIRACA).

## 4. Academic activities

The academic activities will be framed as internships in national or foreign military centres, units or organizations national or foreign.

### 5. Assessment system

The academic tutor (DIRACA) will evaluate the External Internship (PEXT) based on the following information provided by the Military Director (DIRMIL) and the evidence collected on the student's PEXT performance conditions of the student's PEXT.

# The evaluation tools will be as follows:

- 1. The information gathered by the Academic Director (DIRACA) about the conditions that do not depend on the student and in which they has carried out the internship.
- 2. The Military Director's report (DIRMIL), which will evaluate the student's work based on the student's competencies and learning results of the subject.
- 3. The final interview of the Academic Director (DIRACA) with the student, in which they will give an account of the student's performance achieved based on the evaluation criteria.

The evaluation criteria will be based on the competencies and learning results of the subject, assessing the following abilities

- Ability to plan, budget, organize, direct and control tasks, people and resources.
- · Ability to solve problems and make decisions with initiative, creativity and critical reasoning
- Ability to communicate and transmit knowledge, skills and abilities in Spanish.
- Ability to work in a multidisciplinary group and in a multilingual environment.
- · Ability to learn continuously and develop autonomous learning strategies.
- Ability to function in a professional environment, developing tasks typical of the first jobs as an officer.
