2. Learning results

Mode A will consist of an original and integrative report based on the activities carried out throughout the Master (annual programming of a subject, didactic unit, innovation or research project, implementation of activities, Practicum experience, etc.). It is proposed that the MFP contains, in an integrative manner, the following:

2. - Theoretical and/or methodological justification: Justification for the choice of the practical element to be emphasized when writing the MFP as well as the theoretical and methodological premises that support it

- 4. Critical reflection: Final reflection integrating the training received and the practice carried out
- 5. Conclusion.
