1. General information

Based on the specific competences of the degree, the objective of the Master's Final Project (MFP) subject is that students exercise their capacity for reflection and synthesis on their own training process, which includes not only theoretical training, but also its practical application through the professional and life experience of the Practicum in the internship centres.

This approach and objectives are aligned with the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) of the United Nations 2030 Agenda (), so that the company's Agenda 2030 of the United Nations (<https://www.un.org/sustainabledevelopment/es/>), in such a way that the acquisition of the learning results of the subject will contribute to the achievement of goals 4, 5, 10, 16 and 17.

The Master's Final Project (MFP) is a compulsory subject of the second semester. It is synthesized in a written report that is presented and defended before a board of examiners

2. Learning results

1. Develop an academic work containing original contributions by applying the knowledge, skills, aptitudes and attitudes acquired throughout the master's studies.
2. Work autonomously and responsibly to achieve the proposed objectives.
3. Critically evaluate their own work.
4. Present their work, both orally and in writing, and defend it with order, clarity, argumentative rigor and linguistic correctness.

5. Assessment system

Students may complete a MFP of the following types:

- Type 1: It will consist of an original and integrative report. Based on at least two of the activities carried out during the Master
- Type 2: Theoretical reflection on a topic
- Type 3: Curricular design of didactic sequences
- Type 4: Informed design of a teaching innovation project

The paper will be written and defended publicly in French.

ASSESSMENT CRITERIA

A. Competences to synthesize and integrate the acquired learning and to contribute own ideas (60%) - Foundation and references

- Training and professional maturity
- Capacity for analysis and reflection

B. Written communication skills (20 %)

- Respect of the established format
- Structure and expository order

- Respect of citation and referencing rules
- Adequate and coherent organization of the various sections of the work
- Demonstrated level of general and professional speech
- Written expression, spelling and grammatical correctness

C. Oral communication skills (20 %)

- Mastery and understanding of the subject matter
- Clarity, rhythm and organization of the presentation
- Oral expression, pronunciation and grammatical correctness
- Use of body language and voice
- Selection of key information
- Ability to synthesise
- Respect of established times

Adequate and pertinent argumentation in response to the questions and comments of the members of the Board.
