1. General information

The objective of this target is to enable students to apply the knowledge acquired during their academic training to different workplaces, favouring the acquisition of skills in the exercise of professional activities. Internships may be carried out in companies, public or private entities, organizations and institutions that have signed an Educational Cooperation Agreement with the University of Zaragoza.

The objectives of this subject are aligned with some Sustainable Development Goals, SDGs, of the 2030 Agenda (<https://www.un.org/sustainabledevelopment/en/>), depending on the activities carried out, such as: SDG2, Zero Hunger; SDG3, Health and Wellbeing; SDG4, Quality Education; SDG5: Gender equality; SDG6, Clean water and sanitation; SDG8, Decent work and economic growth; SDG9, Industry, innovation and infrastructure, SDG12, Responsible production and consumption; SDG13, Climate action.

2. Learning results

1. To understand the role of the master's graduate in the different public and private organizations and entities in which they can perform their professional activity.
2. To be able to advise in the production and processing of food in different types of food industries.
3. To perform the usual activities of a food analysis laboratory.
4. To know the activity of an R&D&I department in a food industry.
5. To know which are the quality management systems within the industries and to implement quality assurance systems.
6. To perform activities related to food marketing and market research.
7. To apply the knowledge acquired to the analysis of new situations, problem solving and decision making in real contexts.
8. To organize and plan autonomously the work and information management.
9. To work in a team, understand the proposals of other specialists and possess interpersonal skills in the work environment.
10. To have an ethical commitment in all activities derived from professional work.
11. To produce an activity report describing the proposed objectives and the activities carried out during the internship in the chosen place.

4. Academic activities

- At the beginning of the subject, a first meeting will be held with the students to inform them about the schedule and the entities where they can conduct the internships.

- In a second meeting, students will be informed of the company to which they have been assigned and the academic tutor who will be in charge of monitoring their internships and supervising the report.

- Upon completion of the internship (minimum 300 hours) the student must submit to the tutor the final report of the internship 15 days prior to the date of submission of the first or second calls.

5. Assessment system

1: The tutor of the entity will assess the activity developed by the student during the internship in the collaborating entity. For this purpose, they will use a document provided by UNIVERSA. Once the document has been completed, it will be sent both to

UNIVERSA and to the academic tutor at the end of the internship. This assessment report will account for 60% of the student's overall grade in the course.

2: Presentation of the written report of activities, which will consist of:

- Index
- Student's personal data
- Data of the collaborating entity
- Abstract in English and Spanish (300 words)
- Description of the company or entity where the internship was performed and its activities.
- Description of the objectives
- Specific and detailed description of the tasks performed and departments in which the internship was conducted.
- Assessment of the tasks performed in relation to the knowledge and skills acquired in the master's degree.
- Bibliography

The report should be between 20 and 25 pages long (Times 12, 1.5 spacing). The academic tutor's grade will account for 40% of the overall grade. The academic tutor will complete the "Internship Report Evaluation Questionnaire".
