1. General information

The main objective of this subject is to provide students with an introduction to relevant concepts and aspects of different pedagogical models (methods and approaches) of teaching/learning English as a second language or as a foreign language. Through a combination of theory and practice, students will also learn how to design activities for teaching English and evaluate language teaching materials. The subject provides a basis for the students' future professional activity related to language teaching.

2. Learning results

Apply the pedagogical models (approaches and methods) studied to the development of a didactic unit.

Critically evaluate the quality of teaching materials for English language teaching.

4. Academic activities

- Participative theoretical and practical classes

The contents of the subject will be presented and discussed, with a practical orientation toward the analysis of pedagogical models of teaching/learning and the design of didactic programs of English as a second or foreign language in different classroom contexts.

- Individual and group work activities

Preparation, analysis and solution proposal of specific activities on topics of teaching and learning English as a foreign language.

- Group seminars

Practical work oriented to the lesson preparation.

- Teaching assignments

Preparation of a lesson

- Study and personal work

5. Assessment system

First call

A) Continuous assessment system: For students who attend 80% of the face-to-face activities. 3 mandatory tests

a) Intermediate written test (topics 1-3) theoretical-practical (40% of the grade, minimum 4.5 out of 10)

b) Written test (topics 4-6)
theoretical-practical (30% of the grade, minimum 4.5 out of 10)

c) Lesson preparation (30 % of the grade, minimum 4.5 out of 10)

B) Global assessment test For students who have not passed the continuous assessment.

a) Theoretical-practical written test (70% of the grade, minimum 4.5 out of 10)

b) Lesson preparation (30 % of the grade, minimum 4.5 out of 10)

Second call

Global assessment test, with the same tests and in the same terms as those indicated for the first call.

Assessment criteria:

1. Ability to apply knowledge of didactics and pedagogy of languages to the English language.
2. Capacity for analysis, reflection and critical capacity.
3. Autonomy and creativity in the development of didactic programs.
4. Ability to design effective English as a foreign language learning activities.
5. Fluency and correctness in the use of the English language at level C1.2.
